MO Hall Fire Drill Coming Soon - Read to Stay Safe

We are required to do one Fire Drill each semester, and ours is coming up soon. Here are a few things to keep in mind.

- **You Must Evacuate:** A fire in a residence hall is a serious and potentially fatal matter. You are required by policy and law to leave the building any time the alarm sounds. You could incur steep fines and even jail time for not leaving.
- **Exit Quickly and Calmly:** Leave your room and go to the nearest stairwell, which is usually the one at the end of your wing. With 500 people using the stairs, it is imperative that you move quickly and calmly and use the closest stairwell. It will be hard to evacuate if everyone uses the two center stairwells.
- **Make Your Way to the Quad Side of the Bell Wall:** This is where we meet to count and see who is missing. This also keeps everyone out of the path of the fire trucks. We don't want anyone getting run over.
