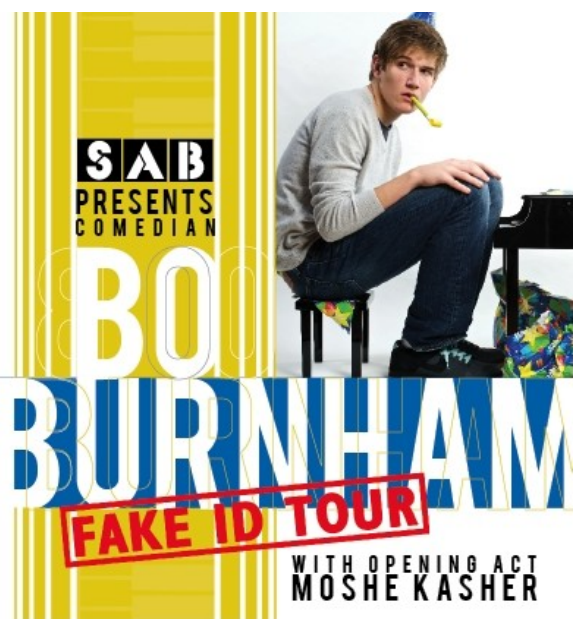
### SAB Offers Great Upcoming Events for November

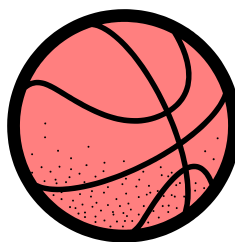
